Benefits

- **Minimally invasive** Composite bonding typically doesn't require enamel removal.
- **Cost-effective** Composite bonding is one of the least expensive cosmetic dental procedures available.

- Fast and convenient Other cosmetic procedures, like veneers and crowns, require multiple appointments. Dental bonding can be completed in just one office visit.

Risks

Although composite material is somewhat stain-resistant, it doesn't resist stains as well as porcelain restorations.

Another disadvantage is that bonding isn't as long-lasting as other restorative options, such as veneers or crowns. Also, bonding materials can chip over time.

In general, composite bonding is an excellent solution for making small cosmetic changes.

ABOUT COMPOSITE BONDING

Composite bonding offers a solution for minor damage or gaps in teeth. A composite resin is attached to a tooth and shaped to restore its original appearance. The colour of the resin is matched to your teeth, so it will appear as though it is a natural part of the tooth.

Fast and effective

Composite bonding can usually be carried out in just one visit to the dentist. It's a fast and effective way to fix minor cosmetic issues.

The composite is hardened using curing light as soon as it's applied, resulting in a tooth that can comfortably bite down by the end of the appointment.

Non-invasive

Bonding is also a non-invasive procedure. With alternatives such as **crowns** and **veneers**, part of the tooth is permanently removed.

For composite bonding to be applied, the surface of the tooth only has to be roughened to help the resin to bond, meaning the structure of the tooth remains intact.
